

## **Instructions for manuscript preparation** **- 'Scientific Papers of Pomology'**

Journal publishes results of applied research from the field of fruit growing. Articles are published in Czech language with abstracts in Czech and English language. Also tables and figures are translated into English. The author is fully responsible for originality of the paper and formal correctness. The article must be original. The paper must not be published previously elsewhere.

Manuscripts must be submitted in Word text editor.

Articles shall not be longer than 8 standard pages (including tables and figures).

Adjustment of the text in computer:

- page format A 4
- single-space lines
- margins – 2.5 cm

Subdivision of text:

**Title.** Bold, upper case, size 14. The Latin names of plants and animals in the title are to be in italic font in parenthesis, bold.

- Include blank line

**Translation of the title into English.** Bold, size 12, lower case.

- Include blank line

**Authors of the manuscript.** Size 12 as follows: The first letter of the given name and surname (without degree), names of more authors are separated by comma. Address follows with the same.

- Include 3 blank lines

**Abstract - English.** Translation of Czech abstract. Text as a single paragraph, in italic. The abstract should not go to more than 170 words.

- Include 2 blank lines

**Key words - English.** Translation of Czech key words. Keywords should be different from words mentioned in the title. Use italics and separation by comma.

- Include 2 blank lines

**Abstract - Czech.** is an important and short summary of the whole paper (as a single paragraph in italics). The abstract should contain a concise but comprehensive statement of the problem and results. The abstract should not go to more than 170 words.

- Include 2 blank lines

**Key words - Czech.** Keywords should be different from words mentioned in the title (recommended 5). Use italics and separation by comma.

- Include 2 blank lines

**Introduction.** Do not designate as a heading.

This should include a statement of the problem, a brief survey of previous work (references) and the purpose of the research.

The main text subdivided into the particular headings follows. The headings are separated by a blank line.

### **Material and methods**

The methods used, lay-out and scope of conducted experiments are described in detail in this part. All procedures that were used for the evaluation of obtained data should also be described. If published method is used, it is sufficient to cite the author of it and mention only particular differences, if any. An indication of the statistical methods and software used to analyze data should be included.

### **Results and discussion**

In this section, the results obtained from experiments including their statistical evaluation and interpretation should be presented graphically or in tables. Using scientific arguments, obtained results should be commented. The author should compare obtained results with results published by other authors (name and year of publication).

Literature Cited. Use single paragraph. Provide a hanging indent (1.2 cm) on the second line of the Literature Cited references. Citations should be stated in the language of the original publication. Citations to references in the text should be arranged in alphabetical order according to surnames of first authors. The names of all authors should be followed by the year of publication cited.

### **Bibliographical references and citation of documents according to Czech technical standards ISO 690 (01 0197) valid from the 1st April 2011.**

#### **References in the text:**

- 1 and 2 authors – state both (Roldán a Bláha 1994),
- 3 and more authors – state the first and add et al. (Bissett et al. 1996),
- particular citations separate by comma (Robertson 1971, Hughes 1988).

**Names of cultivars** designate by single quote mark – example: ‘Golden Delicious’

**Abbreviations and units.** If abbreviations are used in the paper, they should be explained appropriately, when they are used in the text for the first time. Do not use abbreviations in the title of the paper or in abstract. The International System of Units (SI) should be used.

**Tables** in Word editor or in MS Excel spreadsheet application. Tables should be numbered using Arabic numerals in the order, in which they are referred to in the text. The caption should be aligned with the width of the Table. The English translation should be in italics. Accessions in tables or figures, which are translated into English, should be designed by number with parenthesis in superscript.

**Example:**

**Figures** must be provided in MS Excel. All figures should be numbered using Arabic numerals in the order, in which they are referred to in the text. The caption should be aligned with the width of the figure. The English translation should be in italics. The same format as in the tables.
